The Peabody Health Department is offering **FREE Food Safety Training** sessions for International Festival vendors and food handlers. These 90-minute training sessions will include discussion of ***Foodborne Illness and Prevention, Good Hygiene Practices, and Equipment Cleaning and Sanitizing.***

The training sessions are open to the public and will be offered on Thursdays, August 16 and August 23 at 4:00 pm.

LOCATION: Lower level conference room, Peabody City Hall, 24 Lowell St. Peabody

This is a great opportunity to improve your Food Safety Program and is required for festival food vendors who will not have a certified food safety manager on-site during the festival.

We hope that you will take this opportunity to train or re-train your staff, at no cost to you, in food safety principles.
