FLOATING PUBLIC HEALTH SCHOOL NURSE – PART-TIME (2 VACANCIES)

The City of Peabody Department of Health and Human Services is seeking **Registered Nurses** to work as float nurses in Peabody public schools on a part-time basis (up to 19.75 hours per week during the school year). Positions will start the week of August 28, 2017.

The general duties are to administer prescription and non-prescription medications according to school policy and in compliance with 105 CMR 210; provide first aid; chart all immunizations, physicals, vision and hearing results, postural screenings and heights and weights; maintain logs and document the activities of the school health clinic; and perform other related nursing duties in the school setting.

In addition, nurses may participate in immunization clinics, investigate and report communicable diseases per state regulations, conduct vision and hearing tests and other screenings, attend meetings, and perform other public health related duties.

Minimum Requirements: Candidates must possess a valid Registered Nurse (R.N.) license from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and have current certification in CPR and First Aid. A BSN from an accredited School of Nursing and School Nurse Certification are preferred.

Pay rate: \$24.50 per hour. No benefits
