### **PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE** **JUNE 12, 2014**

P426-14 COUNCILLOR GOULD – Reporting for the Public Services Committee – The Public Services Committee met this evening; present was myself, Councillor Walsh, Councillor Moutsoulas and Councillor Gravel sitting in for Councillor Manning-Martin. We had a good meeting. We had a number of boards and committees. Mayor Bettencourt spoke on the numerous projects going on in the city and how much time is spent on these projects. As I said, we had a number of heads of boards and commissions. Mr. Horowitz spoke about making sure that the Health Department will make every effort to reply to requests for info on Special Permits as it's presented to us. Mr. Panos spoke about the Zoning Board of Appeals and the role that the ZBA will also provide. Ms. Schaffer gave us an overview of the Viewpoint permitting system and she's going to make a presentation before the council. Councillor Gravel hit the nail on the head when he brought up the issue of the occupancy permits being the way to ensure conditions are met. We all agreed to schedule a presentation for the City Council and any members of the boards and commissions that would like to attend. We also had a discussion about a co-motion Councillor Walsh and Councillor Driscoll had made regarding the Prospect Street fire station plywood being

removed and dressed up. As Councillor Walsh stated, it is an eyesore and sends a wrong message to the public. Chief Pasdon and Joe Dasilva from Fire Alarm spoke about the possibility of tearing down the structure, which may cost up to \$10,000. They also said they had a quote to frame and side the area where the plywood is today and that is also approximately \$10,000. Councillor Walsh asked to please review the situation and see if there's a more cost-effective method to fix the issue. Chief Pasdon and Mr. Dasilva said they would review their options. Ironically we had somebody from US Roofing in the audience say that if we buy the material, he'll possibly do it for free. At least there's attention being paid to that and we'll see what we can do from here. (Report received)


