Except as otherwise provided by law, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than two hours, at any time between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday except legal holidays on the following described streets or parts thereof:

Foster Street, northwesterly side, from a point beginning at the right of way entrance to 119 Foster Street to a distance 280 feet northeasterly of said beginning point.

Foster Street, southwesterly side, from a point beginning at the corner of Lowe Street to a distance 205 feet southeasterly of said beginning point.

SECTION TWO: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law. . (Unanimous)
