LICENSE and REGISTRATION must be shown when purchasing stickers. There will be NO mail order sales. The parking spaces are limited and will be sold on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVE basis. Stickers can only be used in designated marked spaces in the following downtown parking lots: CENTRAL STREET, FOSTER STREET, MILL STREET. NICHOLS LANE, AND RAILROAD AVENUE.

RESIDENT PARKING PASS RULES

- 1) Parking spaces designated for the nonexclusive use of residential parking are located in the following municipal parking lots:

Foster Street Municipal Lot
Nichols Lane Municipal Lot
Mill Street Municipal Lot
Central Street Municipal Lot
Railroad Avenue Municipal Lot
- 2) The annual cost based on a calendar year (January 1st to December 31st), for one, residential parking pass is \$1,000.00.
- 3) Resident parking pass cost is pro-rated at the time of initial purchase in the calendar year.
- 4) Payments for resident parking passes are non-refundable.
- 5) Resident parking pass is not transferable except when transferring to a new car. In the event of transferring to a new car, change must be recorded at the City Clerk's Office.
- 6) Resident parking passes are issued on a first come, first serve basis.
- 7) Residential parking passes shall not be permitted for trucks or commercial vehicles.
- 8) Resident parking pass must be displayed in the front, lower left portion of the windshield.
- 9) Vehicle shall not be parked in the same parking space for more than 48 consecutive hours.
- 10) When Emergency Parking Bans are in effect, if the ban is rescinded prior to midnight the vehicle must be removed within two (2) hours of rescission. If the ban is rescinded after midnight, the vehicle must be removed prior to 8:00 a.m.
- 11) For ordinance detail, see Section 19-108.1. - Municipal parking lots; residential parking.
- 12) Penalty for violation of Section 19-108.1 is \$15.00 per offense [19-117; Group C (17)]
