

COVID-19 Homebound Vaccination Update

The City of Peabody is pleased to announce it is partnering with the Massachusetts State In-Home Vaccination Program to offer at-home COVID-19 vaccination for Peabody residents who are medically homebound and would otherwise not be able to access vaccination. Any Peabody resident who is homebound and within the current phase of eligibility for vaccination can register to be considered for an in-home vaccination.

The State Program will be responsible for all aspects of the in-home vaccination program, including intake, screening for eligibility, scheduling, vaccine administration, and reporting. The State plans on starting at-home vaccinations by the end of March.

The City of Peabody will be supporting this process by providing prescreening of residents who may be eligible for the In-Home program. If you would like to be placed on the State's call-back list for this program, you or your caregiver can call the Peabody Board of Health COVID-19 Information line at 978-538-5921. We will share your contact information with the State Program, who will be reaching out to interested individuals for intake and screening starting the week of 3/15. It may take several weeks for an at-home appointment to be made available.
