Sealed bids, addressed to Office of the Purchasing Agent, City Hall, 24 Lowell Street, Peabody, MA 01960, will be received until **2:00 PM, prevailing local time, Tuesday February 28, 2023** and then publicly opened and read for:

#### **RECONSTRUCT BRIDGE NO. P-03-014, ENDICOTT STREET OVER PROCTOR BROOK**

The Bid describes construction of a new 26-foot single span prestressed adjacent deck beam bridge supported on concrete abutments with micropile supports. The proposed 30-foot roadway width will match existing street including a new sidewalk sized to allow the total bridge width to fit within the 50 foot right of way, and shall include all other incidental items described in the Specifications.

Interested contractors are advised that award of the Contract shall be to a firm with MassDOT prequalification for the project, as determined by said Agency and the provisions of work as included with the Bid Documents associated with grant funding. Category of work for this Project is: **BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION** with \$ 1,200,000 project estimated value.

The City of Peabody is not responsible for the accuracy or completeness of bids prepared using documents obtained from any source other than the City Purchasing Agent. Only those firms on record with the City Purchasing Department shall receive communications concerning this Bid, as will be issued after the date on which Bid Documents were first made available.

All bids shall be accompanied by bid security as a bid bond in the form prescribed under MGL Ch. 30 § 39M, in cash, or a certified check, or treasurer's or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company, drawn for an amount of five percent (5%) of the value of the bid; all security made payable to the City of Peabody.

A Performance Bond, as well as a Labor and Materials or Payment Bond, each in such a form as prescribed in the Bid Documents, and issued by a firm properly licensed in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, shall be furnished to the City before the signing of the Contract, by the Contractor who shall be awarded the work. These bonds shall be drawn for One Hundred Percent (100%) of the Total Contract Price.

Minimum wage rates apply as established by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts under authority of M.G.L., Chapter 149, sections 26 to 27G inclusive. The Contractor shall be responsible during the progress of the work for full compliance with these laws by their forces and those of any subcontractors who may be used, including reporting of worker payrolls.

Information herein may be modified by notice to Bidders in Addendum or otherwise as distributed or posted to parties on record from the City Purchasing Department.

The City of Peabody reserves the right to waive any informality in, or to reject any or all Bids, or part(s) thereof, and to accept the Bid deemed most satisfactory to the City, as deemed to be in the best public interest to do so.
