2023 Spring Flushing  
Beginning May 9<sup>th</sup> 2023

Schedule is subject to weather, water demands, and staffing.

Flushing will be done Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 8:00 PM to 12:00 AM beginning Tuesday May 9<sup>th</sup> and continuing for approximately five weeks.

Tentative schedule is as follows:

- May 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, & 11<sup>th</sup> – Areas of Lynn St, Bartholomew St, County St, and Lynnfield St
- May 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, & 18<sup>th</sup> – Areas of Washington St, Perkins St, and Lowell St (Main St to Peabody Rd)
- May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, & 25<sup>th</sup> – Areas of Central St, Andover St, and Lowell St (Larabee Ter to Lynnfield)
- May 30<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, & June 1<sup>st</sup> – Areas of Goodale St, Russell St, and Winona St (Five Corners to Lynnfield)
- June 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, & 8<sup>th</sup> – Areas of Winona St (Five Corners to Rt 1), Birch St, and Lake St

Water main flushing helps to ensure water quality and clarity throughout the system. Residents may experience low pressure while flushing is ongoing in their area. There may be some discoloration in the water during this time. This is due to removal of sediment from the water mains. Discoloration will subside in a short time.

**If you experience discoloration in your home, we recommend turning the cold water on a high-volume faucet to clear lines within your home.**

**We encourage residents to avoid doing laundry during flushing time periods to prevent damage to clothing.**
